
Crew Safety Procedures While Traveling Via Water Taxi

- There will be a set schedule for the boats at call and wrap each day and it is important that the boats leave on time. Please take note of what time your water taxi departs and be on time.
- Lifejackets are available under each seat. Wearing a lifejacket is not mandatory but available to you at all times.
- For your safety we ask that you remain inside the water taxi and seated while underway.
- There is to be NO SMOKING on the boats.
- All persons should wear close-toe, non-skid, and rubber-soled shoes when on the water.
- Be careful not to overload the dock with excess crew and gear.
- Use extreme care while working on boats, barges and docks. Be aware of tripping hazards; always look behind you before stepping back. If you are working near an edge, please partner up or ask for safety personnel to stand by.
- Use extreme care when transferring between shore, boats and barges. Be ready with your gear to ensure quick and efficient loading and unloading. Remove any backpacks and pass all heavy gear to the marine crew, keeping your hands free to stabilize yourself while you transfer.
- Please wait for the water taxi to be tied to the dock and the operator says it's safe to stand and exit.
